



Code Of Conduct

1. Respect all other slope users.
2. Control your speed.
3. Give way to users below and choose a route that will not endanger or alarm them.
4. Leave plenty of room when overtaking.
5. If you have to stop try to do so at the side of the slope.
6. The bottom of the slope should be kept clear at all times - it is not a spectator area or a place to store equipment.
7. Look up and down the slope before setting off.
8. You should not walk on the slope. If you have to do this it should be up or down the sides.
9. In the event of an accident all activity must stop. Everyone is duty bound to assist and witnesses must provide relevant information.
10. Avon Ski Club reserves the right to ask you to leave the slope if you are considered by a Club Official or Instructor not to be abiding by the above Code of Conduct or by the Slope Rules.
